

## 2021 Selection Events v.2

Following discovery of a clash between the BFACT Seniors final event and ABF scheduled events, the Seniors final has been delayed by a week to 8 and 9 May 2021 (amended below).

In 2021 BFACT is looking to have events to select 4 teams to represent the ACT at the ANC:

- Womens
- Open
- Seniors
- Youth

We are looking to hold the Womens selection event on 10 and 11 April 2021, and evening of 9 April if needed (if more than 10 pairs enter). Note entries need to be in before 10:00 am on 9 April 2021. The event will involve a round robin of entered pairs with crossIMP scoring. The top 3 pairs will be asked to form the 2021 ACT Womens team.

The Open involves 2 events:, a qualifying event over 4 Monday evenings from 15 February, and a final on 17 and 18 April 2021. Note entries need to be in before 10:00 am on 12 February 2021. The top 10 contending pairs will qualify to the final. The final will involve a round robin of 10 pairs with crossIMP scoring. The top 3 pairs will be asked to form the 2021 ACT Open team.

The Seniors involves 2 events:, a qualifying event over 4 Monday evenings from 15 March, and a final on 8 and 9 May 2021. Note entries need to be in before 10:00 am on 12 March 2021. The top 10 contending pairs will qualify to the final. The final will involve a round robin of 10 pairs with crossIMP scoring. The top 3 pairs will be asked to form the 2021 ACT Seniors team.

The Youth selection process is still being negotiated.

Womens, Open and Seniors finals will involve 14 board matches scored using the cross-IMP method. A 9 match round robin movement will be used for Open and Seniors, with Womens matches depending on number of entries.

Entry fees:

Qualifying - \$13 per player per session

Finals - \$110 per player

All BFACT affiliated bridge players are invited to participate in these events; noting that they will be held within the requirements of the CBC Covid19 Safety Plan at the Duff Place clubrooms.
